Brock University	TOEFL: iBT minimum of 88 IELTS: minimum of 6.5
Carleton University	TOEFL: iBT of 86 with 22 in writing and speaking and 20 in reading and listening; computer based 237; paper based TOEFL 580 IELTS: 6.5 with minimum of 6.0 in each band
University of Guelph	No official test required. Letter of support from university accepted.
Lakehead University	TOEFL: iBT score of 80 with minimum of 19 in each section; computer based 213 with minimum of 17 in each section IELTS: 6.5 overall with no individual band score less than 6.0. MELAB: minimum of 85. CAEL: minimum of 60.
Laurentian University	No official test required. Letter of support from university accepted (for both English and French).
Nipissing University	No official test required. Letter of support from university accepted. ESL help is available for undergraduate students free of charge.
University of Ottawa	TOEFL: iBT score of 86 with minimum of 22 in writing; computer based 237 with minimum of 4.5 in writing IELTS: 6.5 overall with 6.5 in writing
Queen's University	No official test required. Letter of support from university accepted.
Ryerson University	No official test required. Letter of support from university accepted. Some ESL support is available.
Trent University	No official test required. Letter of support from university accepted.
University of Waterloo	TOEFL: iBT 90 overall with 25 in writing and speaking IELTS: 7.0 overall
Western University	Undergraduate: no official test required. Letter of support from university accepted. Graduates: TOEFL: iBT score of 86 with minimum of 20 in each section; computer based 213; some programs may require a higher minimum score IELTS: 6.0 overall
University of Windsor	No official test required. Completion of form from Windsor.
York University	No official test required. Letter of support from university accepted. Exception: Law – TOEFL: minimum 93 with 22 in writing and speaking
